



Beulah Frey Environmental Scholarship Policies and Procedures

1. A \$1,000.00 award will be available for the 2008-2009 academic year to high school seniors applying to a two or four-year college or university to further their studies in an environmentally-related field. Payment is contingent upon entrance into a qualifying program of study.
2. Graduating seniors from both private and public high schools within ASWP's region are eligible to apply. This region includes the counties of Allegheny, Armstrong, Butler, Beaver, Fayette, Washington, and Westmoreland counties.
3. High school guidance offices within ASWP's region will be notified by mail of the online availability of the application at www.aswp.org.
4. Applicants must submit the following items. Any item(s) enclosed in addition to the requested items will not be considered:
 - 1). **A completed application with related essays**
 - 2). **An official transcript**
 - 3). **A copy of SAT or ACT scores**
 - 4). **One recommendation from a person with whom the student has interacted in environmentally-related activities.**

6. The Scholarship Review Committee will make its choice based on the following criteria: academics, essays, employment and/or volunteer work, extracurricular activities/classes, and recommendation. Phone and/or personal interviews will be held at the discretion of the Review Committee.
7. The Scholarship recipient will be notified in May. In addition, notifications will be sent to the recipient's local newspapers and the recipient's high school guidance counselor.
8. The recipient and parents/guardians will be guests at the Audubon Society of Western Pennsylvania's annual banquet held in late May.
